- **Our students will be highly skilled writers. Our teachers at every grade will be confident and effective instructors of writing.**
- **Our new Homework Policy (Board Policy 6154) will be implemented in order to ensure that homework will be used to help students develop the traits described in the Essential Outcomes.**
- **Our revenues and expenditures will be balanced as we plan for long-term sustainability. We will continue to use our resources to pursue the Essential Outcomes and the academic, social/emotional, and physical success of our students.**
- **Based on Next Generation Science Standards, our students will build a strong, cohesive understanding of science focused on the integration and connections between the four domains of science including engineering and science practices.**
- **Members of our school community will continue to develop consistent practices demonstrating empathy. The focus of this goal will be to encourage empathy through service learning with the inclusion of all students and families into the school and district culture.**
